Small businesses are being forced to pay for additional IT because of the way government asks for information.








Can you get Carer's Allowance?

Does the person you care for get one of these benefits?

You can only qualify for Carer's Allowance if the Person you care for is in receipt of one of the qualifying benefits listed below.

Personal Independence Payment (PIP)

At either the standard or enhanced rate of the Daily Living Component.

The care component of Disability Living Allowance (DLA)

At the middle or highest rate.

Attendance Allowance (AA)

Constant Attendance Allowance (CAA)

At or above the normal maximum rate as an addition to Industrial Injuries



We're also changing the way we publish documents.

All government organisations will use the same, single format for editing documents.

Open Document Format (ODF)

"Agreeing ODF as a common standard would be great as at present the docx vs doc vs pdf vs odf debate goes round and round and wastes a lot of time reformatting."
